Together alongside Cushla Young and myself, we will be creating the strategic plan for the next 3 years to create a place of inclusion, quality outcomes for all students and working hard to meet the needs of our community.

I would also like to take a moment to pass on my sincere thanks to the Board members who have not sought reelection this year. Pauline Thomson, Keri Fleming and Brian Smith. Pauline and Keri have been on the Board for 6 years. Pauline has played a huge role in supporting me to access all the

financial resources I have required to bring our vision to life. She has spent many hours advising and revising budgets. Keri Has been involved in the appointment of the majority of our staff and in doing so, been a huge support in helping ensure I had the skill sets I needed on my team. I would also like to pass on my thanks to Brian who has been an informed ear with any decisions around health and wellbeing as they arose during an interesting past few years. I give thanks that you were sent to us and ask that God blesses you all.

Congratulations to the St John Bosco Tamariki who last weekend and this weekend coming completed their First Holy Communion. An exciting time in their faith journey life. I would like to thank Karen McLean for preparing our tamariki and also Jodie Mehana for being our school liaison. Thank you also to these children's families who have supported them on this special journey. We will continue to pray for you all as you enter this special time of commitment to your faith and ask God to bless you all.

You will be aware this week the Government has removed the COVID-19 Protection Framework and we have now moved to a new long-term approach to managing COVID-19. As noted, masks are no longer strongly recommended in school settings reflecting advice from public health.

Household contacts, including those who have not had COVID-19 in the past 90 days, no longer need to isolate for seven days. Household contacts are recommended to test daily for five days from when the case in their household tests positive and wear a mask when they are out. If they do test positive, they will be considered a case and be required to complete seven days of isolation.

Household contacts who have COVID-19 symptoms should stay home regardless of the result of their rapid antigen test (RAT). People with COVID-19 must continue to self-isolate for seven days.

You will be aware that the Government has announced 26 September 2022 as the Queen Elizabeth II Memorial Day. This will mean that schools will be closed for instruction that day. New Zealand will mark the passing of Queen Elizabeth II with a one-off public holiday on Monday 26 September 2022. This means that our school will be closed on this day.

Our School App (School Apps NZ) is no longer used as a form of notification. We have reduced our communication lines down to HERO and also SeeSaw. We realise that there have been a few changes over the past years and with covid restrictions it has been tough to connect with whanau. Now restrictions have gone we will be working hard to ensure everyone is up to speed with HERO and SeeSaw.


THE POPE'S PRAYER INTENTION SEPTEMBER 2022: Abolition of the Death Penalty






