From the Principals Desk...

Kia ora koutou. It's not long till the term break now. We have our first sitting of our new Board meeting next week on Tuesday. These meetings are held in the staffroom and begin at 6:00pm. I'm really looking forward to working with existing and new members to our Board.

On Sunday we will be holding our school mass at Our Lady Help of Christians Church. This begins at 10:30a.m and I'd like to extend a warm invitation to all families to join us. We are collecting for the Food bank so we would love any donations on Sunday and also will gladly collect them next week at school as well.

Just following on from last week's covid announcements. You will be aware that the Government has removed the COVID-19 Protection Framework and we have now moved to a new long-term approach to managing COVID-19. Also noted was, masks are no longer strongly recommended in school settings reflecting advice from public health. There is no requirement to inform school but if you do it is really appreciated as we can then monitor how our community is tracking.

Household contacts, including those who have not had COVID-19 in the past 90 days, no longer need to isolate for seven days. Household contacts are recommended to test daily for five days from when the case in their household tests positive and wear a mask when they are out. If they do test positive, they will be considered a case and be required to complete seven days of isolation.

Household contacts who have COVID-19 symptoms should stay home regardless of the result of their rapid antigen test (RAT). People with COVID-19 must continue to self-isolate for seven days.

Next week we will begin releasing progress reports for

children through HERO. Keep an eye out for these. If you are not receiving notifications through HERO try signing out and in again to refresh the app.

I hope you all enjoy the extra long weekend due to Queen Elizabeth's Memorial day.
