Our performances are scheduled for Tuesday 19th September at 6:00pm and Wednesday 20th September at 12.30pm and 6:00pm.

We are at this stage predicting the show will run for just over 1 hour. We are expecting all children to be available for both shows. We are aware that some families will be away on these dates - thank you for letting us know.

Sponsored by the SJB Community Group Tickets are \$10.00 Children under 5 are free if they sit on an adult's knee - let Andrea know when purchasing tickets, as numbers are limited Tickets are GA (no allocated seating)

Production Update & Evening Performance Logistics:

As we have 274 children to get ready for the show we would like to stagger the arrival of children. This will help us to ensure those helping with make up etc do not get flooded.

Therefore we are asking that children arrive at the following times...

Room Kauri, Totora, Rimu - 5:00 pm. Room Kowhai, Pohutukawa, Karaka - 5:15 pm

Room Nikau, Horoeka,Koromiko, Kawakawa, Puriri and Harakeke -5:25 pm.

If you have children required at multiple times, we do not expect you to make a series of trips. Please bring all your family to our venue at one time, preferably a mid-time frame for all children.

At the end of the performance: Room Kauri, Totora, Rimu students will be collected from the loading dock at the back of the TSB showplace (King Street) Please be aware that there will be **NO parking** available in the loading dock.

Room Kowhai, Pohutukawa, Karaka, Nikau, Horoeka, Koromiko, Kawakawa, Puriri and Harakeke tamariki can be picked up from the circle (the second level at the venue) when they are dressed back into their mufti clothing.

ALL Children will be required to be sighted by an adult before they leave.

Most costumes and makeup have been organised at school. If children require any further bits and pieces, class teachers will have sent notes home. If you are able to help with makeup, changing etc. Please let your child's teacher know.

Children's costumes will be at the venue, ready to get changed into. This means that children can come to the production in mufti clothing. We now need all children to bring a sturdy bag to store their costumes in. Costumes will be collected and kept with the class teacher at the end of each performance. This means at the end of the show, children will take 5-10 minutes to get changed back into their mufti clothing. Children will not be allowed to leave the venue without adult supervision.

We are very fortunate that we have been able to hire the TSB Showplace for our performances. I would like to thank the SJB Community Group for their generous sponsorship of this (thanks to all of our community for supporting their events and fundraising efforts). This is an amazing venue that caters so well for our community and the needs of our production.

If require any further details, please see your child's class teacher.

School Reminders: A gentle reminder that school opens at 8.30am. We have, over the years, allowed students to come into the class from 8:15am. and read quietly until 8.30am. If your child needs to be dropped off earlier, you will need to speak with the class teacher and be aware that <u>teachers are not in</u> <u>the classroom supervising</u> <u>children until 8:30 am.</u>
