#### **Production:**

On the final night I made special mention of some people including our School Board and Community Fundraising Committee for their generous contribution to making a pretty flash and high tech event happen. And we must also acknowledge the genius of Raeleen Luckin for all her script writing, choreography, stage setting, soundwork, lyric writing and just generally elite level of experience and knowledge in the Production sphere. ### **School Board Proprietors Representatives:**

Whilst board elections are happening for our 'parent elect' component of the school board there are also some changes to the "proprietors representatives" on our school board. Ronie Asi and Hamish Gunson, after 12 and 13 years service respectively are stepping down. In 13 years schools see a lot of change in many aspects from curriculum to staffing to property and teaching pedagogy and roll increases. When they began on the board Marie Barrett was the Principal and there were 8 classrooms with just about 200 students.

Their retirement means that joining Kate Buchboek and Jessica Tuki as "proprietor appointed" board members will be Roland Devine and Russell Chamany. Both Roland and Russell are heavily involved in the New Plymouth Parish life at various levels and bring a wealth of experience to the role. Proprietors reps are regular board members who also have a specific focus on ensuring the Special Character of the school is maintained, and that other interests of the Proprietor (Palmerston North Diocese) such as property & tagged teacher requirements are adequately maintained. The 'parent elect' results will be announced later next week.





We invite and encourage you to attend our weekday class Masses where possible.


